This is an immersive voyage where history, culture, and breathtaking scenery unfold day after day. With all excursions curated and arranged for you, the only thing left to do is relax, soak up the tranquillity of the river, and let Egypt's extraordinary stories surround you.

Highlights:

- Marvel at the Great Pyramids of Giza and the treasures of Tutankhamun at the Grand Egyptian Museum.
- Cruise the Nile in comfort from Aswan to Cairo, sailing the full length of Egypt's legendary river.
- Visit the awe-inspiring temples of Abu Simbel, Kom Ombo, and Edfu.
- Explore the magnificent Valley of the Kings and the grand temples of Karnak and Luxor.
- Venture beyond the usual cruise route to see the beautifully preserved temples of Dendera and Abydos.
- Step back in time at the ancient city of Tel El Amarna, following in the footsteps of Akhenaten and Nefertiti.

What's included:

Full Itinerary

Day 1: Arrive In Cairo

Upon arrival in Cairo you will be transferred to your hotel for a comfortable overnight stay, preparing for the adventure ahead.

ACCOMMODATION: 4* Baron Hotel Heliopolis or 5* Hilton Pyramids Golf, Cairo or similar



Day 2: Pyramids and Grand Egyptian Museum

Today, after breakfast, you will begin your adventure with a visit to the Grand Egyptian Museum – a landmark project that took Egypt over ten years to complete. It houses the largest collection of Pharaonic treasures in the world, including the magnificent artefacts of Tutankhamun.

Later, you will head to the Giza Plateau to enjoy lunch with spectacular views of the iconic Pyramids.

Afterwards, explore the Pyramids themselves and admire the enigmatic Sphinx before returning to your hotel for the evening.

Day 3: Cairo City Tour and onwards to Aswan

Enjoy breakfast and a leisurely free morning. Before lunch, you will head out to explore Old Cairo.

After dining at an authentic local restaurant, your tour continues with visits to both Coptic and Islamic Cairo, where centuries of history and faith intertwine. In the evening, you will transfer to the railway station to board the overnight Egyptian sleeper train to Aswan.

Dinner will be served in your cabin, airline-style, as you travel south along the Nile Valley.

ACCOMMODATION: Overnight train from Cairo to Aswan

Day 4: Highlights of Aswan

Upon arrival in Aswan, board your Nile cruise boat and begin your sightseeing with a visit to the High Dam. From there, continue to the Unfinished Obelisk, an extraordinary monument frozen in time that offers a rare insight into the ancient stone-carving techniques of the pharaohs.

Visit the Temple of Philae, dedicated to the goddess Isis, beautifully relocated to its island setting after the construction of the dam. Surrounded by the Nile's shimmering waters, this temple is one of Egypt's most atmospheric sites.

Later in the afternoon after lunch, unwind with a traditional felucca sailing trip, gliding gently along the Nile and passing the picturesque islands of Aswan, where palm trees, ancient rocks, and elegant domed mausoleums rise from the riverbanks.

Stay overnight onboard your cruise boat.

Day 5: Abu Simbel and Kom Ombo

After breakfast, you will travel to Abu Simbel, a journey of around four hours drive each way. The trip is well worth it, as Abu Simbel is considered the greatest temple complex in Egypt, a true masterpiece of ancient civilisation.

Upon returning from Abu Simbel, you will begin sailing towards Kom Ombo, where you will visit the unique double temple dedicated to Sobek and Horus. Afterwards, continue sailing to Edfu, where you will stay overnight on board.

Day 6: Edfu and Esna Lock

Early in the morning, visit the Temple of Edfu, the best-preserved temple in all of Egypt and a magnificent example of Ptolemaic architecture. After your visit, return to the boat for breakfast while sailing towards Esna.

Here you will experience the fascinating process of crossing the Esna Lock, where the boat is carefully lowered from the higher water level of the Upper Nile to the lower level below.

This is an impressive sight, as the lock gradually fills and releases water, allowing your vessel to pass through. Continue sailing towards Luxor, enjoying a full day of leisurely cruising along the Nile, watching timeless riverside villages, palm groves, and farmlands unfold before you.

Day 7: Exploring Luxor's West Bank

This morning, you will explore the West Bank of Luxor, beginning with the Valley of the Kings, the ancient royal necropolis where Egypt's pharaohs were laid to rest.

Continue to the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, an architectural masterpiece built into the cliffs of Deir el-Bahari, and finish with a stop at the Colossi of Memnon, the towering statues that have guarded Thebes for millennia. Afterwards, return to the boat for lunch.

In the afternoon, visit the magnificent Karnak Temple complex, the largest religious site of the ancient world, followed by the elegant Luxor Temple. Later, return to the boat for your overnight stay.

Please note:

Your visit to the Valley of the Kings includes access to the following tombs (subject to site regulations on the day) - Ramesses VII, Ramesses III, Merneptah, Ramesses IV, Ramesses IX, Ramesses I, Siptah, Tausret. Access to the following tombs is not included in the standard ticket and can be added at an additional cost: Tutankhamun, Seti I and Ramesses VI

Day 8: Luxor to Qena

After breakfast, sail north towards Qena, where you will visit the beautifully preserved Temple of Dendera, dedicated to the goddess Hathor.

This site is renowned for its vivid astronomical ceiling, impressive columns, and sacred sanctuary. In the evening, continue sailing to Naga Hammadi, where you will spend the night.

MEALS INCLUDED: Breakfast, lunch, dinner

Day 9: Abydos and Sailing to Sohag

Sail onward to El Balyana, where you'll visit the Temple of Abydos, one of Egypt's most important cult centres, dedicated to Osiris, God of the afterlife.

Return to the boat and continue the journey north toward Sohag. Spend the evening on board with entertainment and overnight in Sohag.

Day 10: Monastery of Prince Tawdrous and Tel El Amarna

Cruise from Sohag toward Tel El Amarna, passing through the Asyut Lock. Along the way, a guided explanation as you view Prince Tawdrous Monastery from the boat, an important Coptic Christian landmark on the Nile.

Arrive at Tel El Amarna and overnight on board.

Day 11: In the Footsteps of Akhenaten

Today, explore the ancient city of Tel El Amarna, the short-lived capital of Pharaoh Akhenaten and Queen Nefertiti. Here you'll see the Northern Tombs, the Royal Tomb of Akhenaten, the Northern Palace, and the Small Temples of Aten, all reflecting Egypt's brief experiment with monotheism.

Continue to Ashmunein, once a centre dedicated to Thoth, and then on to Tuna El Gabal, famous for its catacombs, animal necropolis, and painted tombs that blend Egyptian and Greco-Roman traditions. Afterwards, relax on board as you sail to Minya for an overnight stay.

Day 12: Beni Hassan Tombs and Sailing to Beni Suef

Journey to the cliffs of Beni Hassan, where rock-cut tombs reveal colourful scenes of daily life, wrestling, agriculture, and foreign delegations from over 4,000 years ago. Among the most impressive are the tombs of Baqet III, Khety, Amenemhat, and Khnumhotep II. After your visit, sail towards Beni Suef, enjoying the changing Nile landscape. Overnight in Beni Suef.

Day 13: Arrival in Cairo and Old City Tour

Sail into Cairo and step ashore for a tour through the vibrant old city. Stroll along Al-Muizz Street and lose yourself in the colourful alleys of Khan El Khalili Bazaar, where spices, handicrafts, and souvenirs fill every corner. Return to your boat for overnight in Cairo.

After breakfast, disembark from your boat and transfer to Cairo International Airport for your flight home, carrying unforgettable memories of sailing the full length of the Egyptian Nile from Luxor to Cairo.

FAQs

WHAT IS THE MAXIMUM GROUP SIZE FOR EXCURSIONS DURING THE TRIP?

For all guided excursions on this trip, the maximum group size will be 35 people to ensure a comfortable and personalized experience. Please note that while on the Nile cruise, the number of guests on board will naturally be higher, but excursions and activities off the boat will adhere to this maximum limit.

VISAS

British passport holders require a visa for travel to Egypt.

You can apply online for an e-visa, which is valid for up to 3 months, or you can obtain a visa on arrival at the airport before immigration. Please note that your passport should also be valid for at least 6 months from arrival into Egypt. Please check the FCDO website for more information.

HEALTH AND VACCINATIONS

Please note that there are no mandatory vaccinations required to enter Egypt. However, we recommend consulting your GP or a travel health clinic before you travel to ensure your routine vaccinations are up to date and to receive any personalised health advice.

TIPPING

Tipping is customary on Nile cruises and is an important part of the local tourism industry. Most cruise operators, including ours, operate a pooled gratuity system, where guests leave a contribution at reception at the end of the cruise that is shared amongst the onboard crew.

As a guide, we recommend allowing approximately US\$5 per person, per night for cruise staff, with additional gratuities for the Tour Guide at your discretion, given directly to the guide.

SHOPS

Throughout the itinerary, there will be some stops at local shops. If you'd prefer not to participate, please let your guide know. While these shops may be slightly more expensive, they offer the reassurance of guaranteed returns, even after you've returned home.

PHYSICAL ACCESSIBILITY

This tour is suitable for most people with a good level of fitness and normal mobility. It includes activities such as climbing steep stairs, walking on uneven ground during excursions, and getting on and off coaches, vehicles, and boats.

CURRENCY

The official currency in Egypt is the Egyptian Pound (EGP), but USD is widely accepted. We recommend exchanging some currency before leaving the UK for convenience. However, cash machines are readily available in all major cities, allowing you to withdraw money in the local currency if needed.
