## Day 4: Embark Norwegian Star

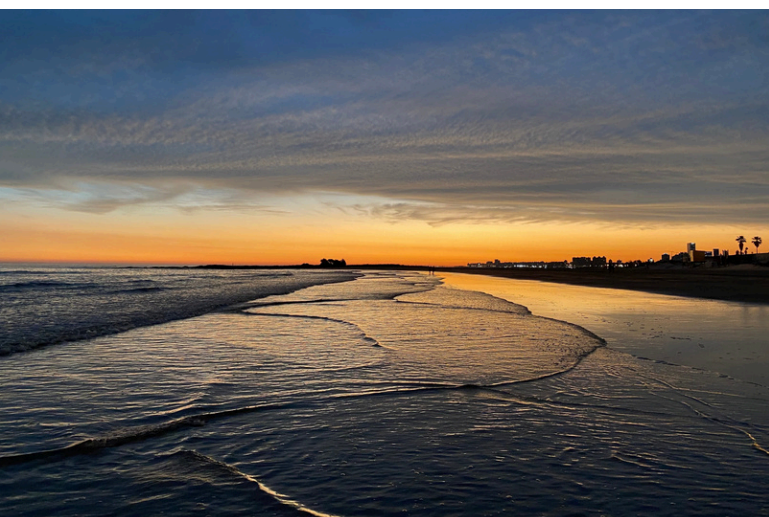

## Day 9: Stanley, Falkland Islands

Whether you're seeking history, wildlife, or simply a peaceful stroll, Port Stanley offers the perfect mix of adventure and relaxation.





## Day 10: Day At Sea

Take a day at sea to unwind aboard Norwegian Star your way. Sip a cocktail on the deck, visit the casino, simply relax in one of the ship's cosy lounges.



## Day 11: Elephant Island (Cape Lookout)

Situated off the coast of Antarctica, Elephant Island takes its name from the elephant seals that call it home and its distinctive, elephant-head shape. Rugged mountains, shimmering ice sheets, and unique wildlife create an unforgettable and remote landscape. Explore at your own pace: watch tuxedoed penguins waddle across the rocky terrain, spot giant elephant seals lounging along the shore, or simply take in the haunting beauty of this extraordinary destination.





## Day 12: Paradise Bay (Cruising)

Paradise Bay is what most imagine when they think of Antarctica, dramatic ice formations, vast blue glaciers, curious penguins, and whales gliding through pristine waters. Situated on the west coast of the Antarctic Peninsula, just north of Lemaire Channel, it offers a rare glimpse into a wild, frozen wonderland. With a hot drink in hand and your camera ready, prepare to take in this surreal, otherworldly landscape with Norwegian.



## Day 13: Day At Sea

Another day aboard Norwegian Star is yours to enjoy at your own pace. Unwind however you like, relax by the indoor pool, or spend the evening in the theatre enjoying one of NCL's spectacular west end style shows.





## Day 14: Ushuaia, Argentina

Arrive to Ushuaia, Argentina at 07:00. Departs at 15:00.

Hike scenic trails surrounded by the sea, forests, lakes, and mountains, and take in the breathtaking views of Tierra del Fuego National Park. Keep an eye out for soaring Andean Condors as you explore this rugged landscape. Ushuaia, one of the main cities in the island territory of Tierra del Fuego, offers plenty to discover at your leisure—whether wandering the town or venturing further into nature.

## VISA

For British passport holders a VISA for Argentina, Antarctica and Chile is not required. Full details can be found on the GOV.UK website. Your passport needs to valid for the duration of your stay.

## INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR CRUISE

Prepaid gratuities are not automatically included in your cruise fare but can be added at the time of booking at an additional cost.
