What's included:

Full Itinerary

Day 1: Fly overnight from the UK to Tokyo, Japan

Fly overnight into Tokyo International Airport.



Day 2: Arrive in Tokyo, Japan

Arrive into Tokyo International where your transfer will be waiting so sit back and relax as you're transferred to your hotel.

Begin your Tokyo adventure with a day at leisure. Explore Tokyo your way and choose to head to Tsukiji Outer Market to sample fresh seafood and vibrant street snacks before heading up the Tokyo Skytree for panoramic city views. As evening falls you could immerse yourself in the dazzling energy of Shibuya Crossing and round off the night in Shinjuku, exploring its neon-lit streets and lively bars.

Accommodation: 5* - The Strings by Intercontinental, Tokyo (or similar).

Day 3: Tokyo, Japan

Continue with your adventure in Tokyo, why not begin with a serene walk through Meiji Shrine, then soak up the youthful energy of Harajuku with its colourful shops, crepes, and pop culture vibes. Continue to Asakusa for a step back in time, where Senso-ji Temple and Nakamise Street offer traditional charm and cultural treasures. End your adventure in the stylish district of Ginza, indulging in gourmet food, sleek bars, or simply enjoying the modern elegance of Tokyo's nightlife.

Accommodation: 5* - The Strings by Intercontinental, Tokyo (or similar).



Day 4: Embark Norwegian Jade®

Enjoy your final morning in Tokyo taking in the last of the sights, before meeting your private transfer to the Port of Yokohama. Here, you'll embark on your cruise aboard Norwegian Jade®, scheduled to depart at 16:00.

Day 5: Sendai (Ishinomaki), Japan

Arrive to Sendai (Ishinomaki) at 10:30. Departs at 18:30.

Sendai is also known as the "City of Trees", famed for its street food, Michelin star restaurants, museums and stunning cityscapes. Its surrounding nature offers dormant volcanoes and magnificent hot springs.



Day 6: Hakodate, Japan

Arrive to Hakodate at 11:00. Departs at 18:30.

Hakodate has a rich history. You will notice the Goryokaku Tower overlooking the city within its star shaped Fort. The fort has witnessed many battles including the historic battle that contributed to the fall of the samurai, marking the end of the Tokugawa shogunate.



Day 7 & 8: Day At Sea

Take time to explore the impressive facilities aboard Norwegian Escape and make the most of your 'More At Sea' perks.



Day 9: Cross The International Date Line

Travel through time by crossing the International Date Line. There is an imaginary line running between the North and South Poles. Crossing time travel off your bucket list in this once in a lifetime experience.

Day 14: Cruise Hubbard Glacier, Alaska

A magnificent glacier standing nearly 400ft tall just over half of its size underwater, spanning 6 miles wide and 76 miles long the Hubbard Glacier is the biggest tidewater glacier in Northern America. This region is renowned for its wildlife. Look out for bald eagles, harbour seals and the magnificent humpback whales and orcas.



Day 15: Icy Strait Point, Alaska

Arrive to Icy Strait Point at 07:00. Departs at 19:00.

The Icy Strait Point is where adventurers find magical experiences. Here you will find lots of walking trails and activities, 3 waterfront restaurants serving fresh seafood, a free museum and a rather unique shopping centre.

Day 16: Juneau, Alaska

Arrive to Juneau at 07:00. Departs at 20:00.

This is the capital of Alaska since 1906. Here you can experience magnificent views of the Mendenhall Glacier, the Tongass National Forest, Tracy Ann Fjord and the Sawyer Glaciers with floating icebergs. Wildlife here is in abundance with eagles, bears, whales and orcas.



Day 17: Skagway, Alaska

Arrive to Skagway at 06:00. Departs at 16:00.

Explore Skagway in just 100 years this little towns population boomed thanks to a gold rush. Still styled within its gold rush days take a walk back in time and experience the excitement of this charming town.



Day 18: Ketchikan (ward cove), Alaska

Arrive to Ketchikan (ward cove) at 11:00. Departs at 20:00.

Translated from its Tlingit Indian name "Kach Khanna" which means "spread wings of the eagle". Just as the name look out for the birds who sit on top of one of the many Sitka trees. Ketchikan's frequent rains nurture some of the world's lushest forests and most wilderness.



Day 19: Cruise Inside Passage, Alaska

Sail Alaska's Inside Passage and experience unforgettable views paired with remarkable wildlife sightings.



Day 20: Vancouver, Canada

Disembark at Vancouver at 07:00

On disembarkation day, leave the comfort of your ship to discover Vancouver, set between the snow-capped North Shore Mountains and the deep blue Pacific. This vibrant city blends urban sophistication with welcoming charm. Enjoy a day to do as you please. After choosing to drop your luggage off at your hotel, a short walk from the Cruise port, we recommend a visit to Queen Elizabeth Park. This 130-acre arboretum features sculptures by modern artist Henry Moore.

Accommodation: 4* EXchange Hotel Vancouver or similar.



Day 21: Vancouver, Canada

After a day of rest get ready for your return flight home where a private transfer will take you to the Vancouver airport for your overnight flight home.

Day 22: Arrive back in the UK

Your overnight flight arrives in the UK ready for you to make your journey home.
