Full Itinerary

Day 1: UK to Miami

Arrive in Miami, where a private transfer will be waiting to take you to your hotel for the start of your two-night stay. The remainder of the day is free for you to relax after your flight or begin exploring this vibrant coastal city. You may wish to take a stroll along South Beach, admire the colourful Art Deco architecture of Ocean Drive, or simply soak up the atmosphere of one of America's most dynamic destinations.

Perhaps spend time relaxing on the city's famous beaches, browse the shops and waterfront restaurants at Bayside Marketplace, or explore the renowned street art and galleries of the Wynwood district. With its blend of tropical scenery, Latin influences and lively atmosphere, Miami offers plenty of opportunities to unwind before embarking on your Caribbean cruise the following day.

Day 3: Miami, Florida, United States

You may wish to spend time relaxing on the famous Seven Mile Beach, browse the shops and cafés around the waterfront, or simply soak up the island's tropical charm. Alternatively, those looking to explore further may enjoy a boat trip to the renowned Stingray City sandbar, where friendly southern stingrays glide through the crystal-clear waters. With its beautiful coastline and welcoming island spirit, George Town offers a wonderful introduction to the Caribbean.



Day 6: Ocho Rios, Jamaica

Arrive in Ocho Rios, Jamaica at 11:00. Depart at 20:00.

Today you arrive in Ocho Rios, one of Jamaica's best-loved resort towns, surrounded by lush tropical scenery and beautiful beaches. You may wish to visit the famous Dunn's River Falls, explore the local markets and shops, or simply relax by the sea and enjoy the island's laid-back atmosphere. Alternatively, those wishing to discover more of Jamaica may enjoy an excursion into the surrounding countryside, where rainforest-covered hills, tropical gardens and spectacular viewpoints showcase the island's natural beauty. Before returning to the ship, perhaps sample some authentic Jamaican cuisine and experience the warmth of the local culture.



Day 7: At Sea

Day 9: Cartagena, Colombia

Arrive in Cartagena, Colombia at 07:00. Depart at 13:00.

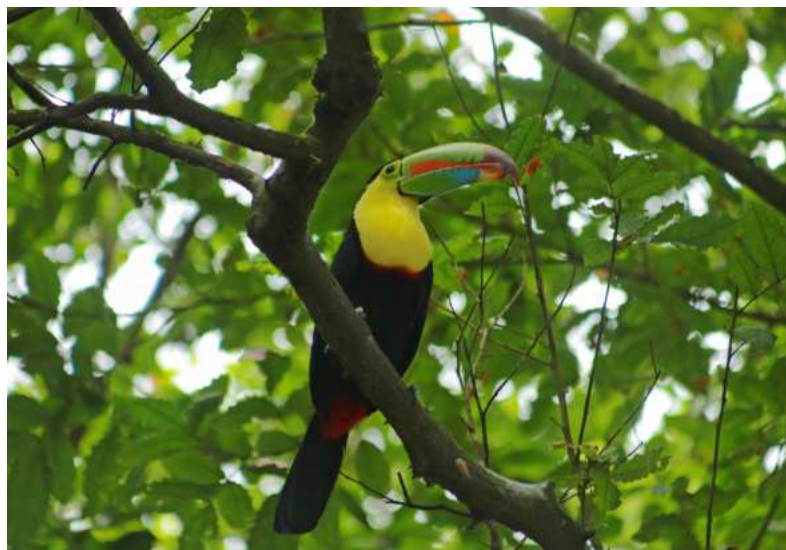

Day 10: Colón, Panama

Arrive in Colón, Panama at 08:00. Depart at 20:00.

Today you arrive in Colón, gateway to one of the world's greatest engineering achievements, the Panama Canal. You may wish to explore local attractions, learn more about the canal's history and construction, or take an excursion into Panama's tropical rainforest. With an extended stay in port, there is ample opportunity to discover this fascinating region before returning to the ship this evening.



Day 11: Panama Canal Daylight Transit

Today promises one of the most memorable experiences of the voyage as Oceania Sirena transits the legendary Panama Canal in daylight. From the deck, watch as the ship passes through a series of locks, lakes and channels that connect the Atlantic and Pacific Oceans. Surrounded by lush rainforest and remarkable engineering, this is a truly unforgettable journey and a highlight for many travellers.



Day 12: At Sea

Day 13: Manta, Ecuador

Day 15: Salaverry, Peru

Day 16: Lima / Machu Picchu (Callao), Peru

Arrive in Lima / Machu Picchu (Callao), Peru at 11:00.

Today you arrive in Callao, the gateway to Peru's vibrant capital, Lima. You may wish to explore Lima's historic centre, sample its world-renowned cuisine, or visit fascinating museums showcasing Peru's rich history. Alternatively, some travellers may choose to begin an unforgettable extension towards Machu Picchu, one of the world's most iconic archaeological sites.



Day 17: Lima / Machu Picchu (Callao), Peru

This morning, disembark Oceania Sirena in Callao. Depending on your flight arrangements, you may have time to enjoy further exploration of nearby Lima, perhaps discovering its historic centre, coastal districts or renowned culinary scene. At the appropriate time, enjoy a private transfer to the airport for your flight home, bringing your remarkable voyage through the Caribbean, the Panama Canal and the Pacific coast of South America to a close.

FAQs

DO I NEED A VISA?

British citizens do not generally require visas for this cruise itinerary when travelling for tourism, including visits to the United States, Cayman Islands, Jamaica, Colombia, Panama, Ecuador and Peru. However, as your holiday begins in the United States, UK passport holders must obtain an approved ESTA prior to travel. Passports should be valid for the duration of your stay, although some countries, airlines or transit points may recommend additional validity. Entry requirements can change, so we recommend checking the latest advice on the UK Government's Foreign, Commonwealth & Development Office (FCDO) website and relevant government travel advice before departure.

DO I NEED ANY VACCINATIONS?

There are no mandatory vaccinations required for UK travellers visiting the destinations on this cruise itinerary. However, we recommend consulting your GP or a travel health clinic before departure to ensure your routine vaccinations are up to date and to obtain any personalised travel health advice. Depending on your planned activities ashore, particularly in parts of Colombia, Panama, Ecuador or Peru, a travel health professional may also recommend additional precautions or vaccinations. Always seek the latest medical advice before travelling.
