Full Itinerary

Day 1: UK to Oslo, Norway

Board your flight from the UK to the elegant Norwegian capital of Oslo. On arrival, transfer to your centrally located hotel and enjoy an overnight stay, giving you time to relax or begin exploring this vibrant waterfront city. Stroll along the harbour, discover its impressive architecture and museums, or enjoy dinner at one of Oslo's many excellent restaurants before your cruise adventure begins the following day.

Day 2: Embark MSC Magnifica

Depart Oslo at 16:00.

Spend the morning discovering more of Oslo before boarding your cruise ship this afternoon. Visit the striking Opera House, explore the fascinating Viking heritage of the city, or relax in one of the cafés overlooking the Oslofjord. Later, meet your private transfer who will take you to the cruise terminal to embark your ship. Settle into your cabin and enjoy dinner on board as your Baltic adventure begins with an afternoon departure from Oslo.



Day 3: Copenhagen, Denmark

Arrive in Copenhagen at 09:00. Depart at 17:00.

Arrive in Copenhagen, Denmark's stylish capital, renowned for its colourful waterfront, royal palaces and relaxed Scandinavian charm. Wander through the picturesque Nyhavn district, visit the famous Little Mermaid statue, or explore the city's elegant streets, cafés and boutiques. Return to the ship this afternoon as your journey continues across the Baltic Sea.



Day 4: Warnemünde, Germany

Arrive in Warnemünde at 07:00. Depart at 17:00.

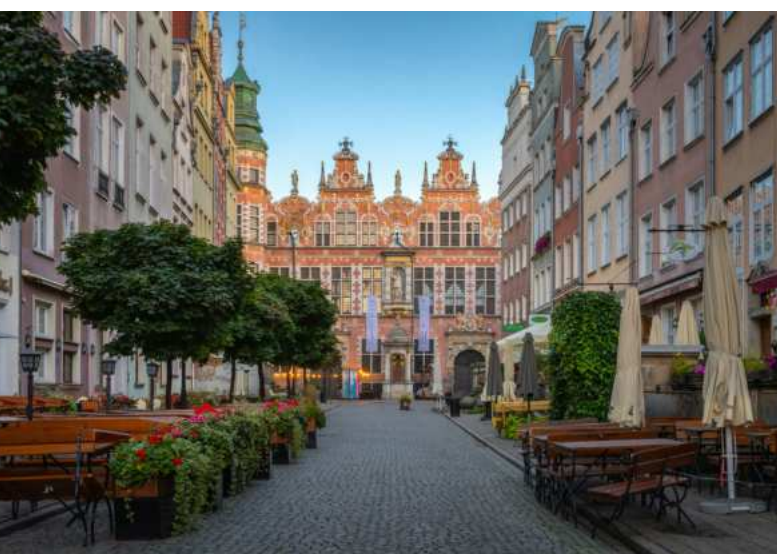
Today, arrive in the charming seaside town of Warnemünde, located on Germany's Baltic coast. Stroll along the picturesque waterfront, browse the local shops and cafés, or relax on the sandy beach. Alternatively, join an optional excursion to discover the UNESCO-listed Hanseatic city of Lübeck, explore the fairytale castles and historic streets of Schwerin and Wismar, or uncover the rich maritime heritage of nearby Rostock. Return to the ship this evening as your Baltic journey continues.



Day 5: Gdynia (Gdańsk), Poland

Arrive in Gdynia at 10:00. Depart at 19:00.

Today, arrive in Gdynia, the gateway to the historic city of Gdańsk. Renowned for its beautifully restored Old Town and rich maritime heritage, Gdańsk is one of Poland's most captivating cities. Wander along the elegant Long Market, admire the colourful merchant houses and historic waterfront, or join an optional excursion to discover the city's fascinating history. Return to the ship this evening as your Baltic journey continues.



Day 6: Klaipėda, Lithuania

Arrive in Klaipėda at 07:00. Depart at 15:30.

Discover Klaipėda, Lithuania's only seaport and a city where German and Lithuanian influences blend together. Explore its charming Old Town with its timber-framed buildings and inviting squares, or join an optional excursion to the spectacular Curonian Spit, a UNESCO World Heritage Site renowned for its rolling sand dunes, forests and coastal scenery. Return to the ship this afternoon as you continue your voyage through the Baltic.



Day 7: Riga, Latvia

Arrive in Riga at 07:00. Depart at 14:30.

Arrive in Riga, the elegant capital of Latvia and the largest city in the Baltic States. Renowned for its beautifully preserved Old Town, impressive Art Nouveau architecture and vibrant café culture, Riga offers plenty to discover. Wander through its cobbled streets, visit the bustling Central Market or admire the city's historic churches and grand squares before returning to the ship this afternoon.



Day 8: Stockholm, Sweden

Arrive in Stockholm at 09:00.

Today, arrive in Stockholm, Sweden's beautiful capital, spread across fourteen islands connected by picturesque bridges and waterways. Known for its elegant architecture, historic Gamla Stan and world-class museums, Stockholm offers the perfect introduction to this captivating Scandinavian city. After disembarking, transfer to your hotel and enjoy an overnight stay, giving you time to explore the city's charming streets, waterfront promenades and excellent restaurants at your leisure.

Day 9: Stockholm to the UK

After breakfast, enjoy any remaining free time in Stockholm before transferring to the airport for your flight back to the UK. Perhaps visit one of the city's renowned museums, browse the boutiques of Gamla Stan or simply relax beside the waterfront before bidding farewell to Scandinavia and returning home with wonderful memories of your Baltic adventure.



FAQs

DO I NEED A VISA?

UK passport holders do not require a visa to enter Norway, Denmark, Germany, Poland, Lithuania, Latvia or Sweden for tourism stays of up to 90 days within a 180-day period. All of these countries are part of the Schengen Area, and this cruise itinerary falls within the permitted visa-free travel period. Passports must meet Schengen requirements, including being issued less than 10 years before arrival and valid for at least three months after your planned departure from the Schengen Area. Please refer to the FCDO website for the latest information before travelling.

DO I NEED ANY VACCINATIONS?

There are no mandatory vaccinations required to enter Norway, Denmark, Germany, Poland, Lithuania, Latvia or Sweden. However, we recommend consulting your GP or a travel health clinic before you travel to ensure your routine vaccinations are up to date and to receive any personalised health advice. Please check the latest guidance before departure.

CAN I CHANGE THIS ITINERARY?

INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR CRUISE.

For your comfort and convenience, embarkation begins at the check-in time shown on your cruise ticket. Web check-in allows you to receive your e-ticket and boarding pass, and you should arrive during your allocated check-in slot. Check-in is available up to 2 days before departure. Boarding/check-in closes 2 hours before the ship's scheduled departure.
