Full Itinerary

Day 1: UK to Reykjavik

Board your flight to Reykjavik. Meet your private transfer and head to your hotel to relax or explore Iceland's capital city. The seafood is amazing, maybe try Nordic salt cod or a fish stew. Or explore the city's artistic boutiques for authentic Icelandic souvenirs and trinkets, like music boxes.

Day 2: Enjoy your morning in Reykjavik

Take in the last of the sights, before meeting your transfer to take you to the port. Here, you'll embark on your cruise aboard Celebrity Silhouette.

Day 5: Seydisfjordur, Iceland

Arrive in Seydisfjordur at 07.00. Depart 18.00

Seydisfjordur is an eclectic little town, tucked away at the end of a deep fjord in the east of Iceland. Surrounded by volcanoes, waterfalls, and in summer, green fields dotted with purple lupins, this former hub for herring fishing is a favorite stop on cruises to Iceland. On a cruise to Seydisfjordur, walk alongside colorful wooden homes and the famous rainbow-painted street leading to the pretty blue church as you enjoy the fresh, crisp air. Immerse yourself in Icelandic art culture, and celebrate Seydisfjordur's rich history as a creative community. Venture through incredible natural surroundings as you trek to the cascading Gufufoss waterfalls, and wander along the shore looking out for seals and porpoises before continuing on your Iceland cruise.



Day 6: Akureyri, Iceland

Arrive in Akureyri at 08.00. Depart at 19.00

Known as the Capital of North Iceland, Akureyri is the country's second-largest city and one of its most important fishing ports. This laid-back Nordic city combines a vibrant café culture, excellent dining, and a lively atmosphere with easy access to some of Iceland's most spectacular natural wonders. Explore the city's renowned Botanical Gardens, visit the dramatic lava formations of Dimmuborgir, and discover the geothermal landscapes of Namafjall, where bubbling mud pools and steaming fumaroles showcase Iceland's volcanic power. You can also venture to Grimsey Island, located on the Arctic Circle and home to thousands of seabirds. Surrounded by stunning fjords, snow-capped mountains, waterfalls, and lava fields, Akureyri is the perfect gateway to the breathtaking landscapes and rich culture of North Iceland.



Day 7: Isafjordur, Iceland

Arrive in Isafjordur at 07.00. Depart 18.00

Isafjordur, the largest town in the Westfjords peninsula, is known for its breathtaking landscapes. Here guests can enjoy a wide variety of outdoor activities from biking and hiking to whale watching. They can explore the history of the town that started as a trading post in the 16th century with growth triggered in the 19th century by salt fish production which is still the most important industry for the town.



Day 8: Reykjavik, Iceland

Welcome back to Reykjavik. Take time to enjoy the last memories of this wonderful city. If you're not quite ready to leave, why not extend your holiday with an additional night or two. Reykjavik offers a wide range of excursions, from the iconic Golden Circle tour, glacier hikes or maybe a geothermal spa experience. Make the most of your time here before you are transferred to the airport for your return flight to the UK.

DO I NEED A VISA?

British citizens do not require a Visa to enter Iceland.
